

#### **New Policies**

- Expanded child care subsidy eligibility to 300% FPL
- Higher payment rates for child care for essential workers
- Covering parent co-pay fees
- Teacher and Staff Bonuses
- Child care hotline
- Covering Subsidy and NC PreK whether open or closed

## NC COVID-19 Updates

## **Impacts Child Care Reopening and Rebuilding**

- Stay-at-home extended through May 8
- Phased plan for reopening
  - Depends on testing, tracing and trends
- K-12 public schools closed for the rest of the year. Continue remote learning



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Small Business Loans

- COVID-19 Congress Passed V3.5
- Includes \$480 billion for federal small business loans programs
  - \$320B for Payroll Protection Program
  - \$60B for Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program
- Likely to go just as far eligible applications in the hopper
- Are you ready? Loan application should already be in
  - If not apply now!



## NC Pre-K News



- New guidance on NC Pre-K remote learning (April 22)
- Expectation whether open or closed –
   provide remote learning or in-person if
   part of child care program serving
   essential workers.
- Engage in real-time with parents/caregivers and children twice per week.

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

## **Short Session Overview**

#### **NC General Assembly -**

- April 28 30
- Focus only on immediate COVID-19 related issues through June 30
- Considering all federal funding available (CARES Act) for COVID-19
- Usual process see graphic
- Meeting virtually and In-person votes?



## **Short Session Overview**

#### What we know today –

- House Workgroups presented their plans
  - Health child care included in \$25 bucket for food, safety, shelter & child care
    - No specific amount designated for Child Care
    - PPE could include child care supplies
    - Temporary Waiver of 3 Year Fingerprint requirements for open programs
  - Economic Support \$75M state small business loan program via Golden Leaf

## Governor Cooper

#### Released COVID-19 plan

- only Federal funding
- Total package = \$1.4 billion until July 1, 2020
  - 1. Immediate public health and safety
    - Includes \$25 M same as House for food, shelter, child care
    - Enhanced Personnel safety, equipment and sanitation supplies
  - 2. Continuity of operations for education and state government
    - Public schools, UNC system, Community Colleges, State government operations
  - 3. Small business assistance \$75 Million
    - NC COVID-19 Rapid Recovery Lending Program Already received 3400 applications from 98 counties totaling \$122M since March 24<sup>th</sup>.


