NC Early Education Coalition Becomes a Nonprofit Organization

In July, the NC Early Education Coalition obtained a new organizational status and became a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The Coalition has operated as a 501(c)(6) membership association since its inception, relying on membership dues for the majority of our funding. With the new status, we'll be able to build a stronger Coalition through grants and additional donations, while still maintaining our membership structure and our focus on advocacy and lobbying.
